## Submission Guidelines:

1. Photographs in .jpg format having resolution of 300 dpi, image size 15x10 inches and the maximum size of 5 MB, should be named as *<Title of the photo\_Author name\_cell phone no.>* and sent by email to [isi.women.photography@gmail.com](mailto:isi.women.photography@gmail.com). The organisers may ask for the original camera file/Raw file.
2. Category "OPEN". Each participant is allowed to submit at most two entries.
3. There is no submission fee.
4. Basic editing, including colour enhancement, the use of filters, and cropping of the photo(s) is acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity and / or genuineness of the photo(s).
5. Winners will be awarded with cash prizes. Rs.2000/, Rs.1500/, Rs.1000/ for 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize. The decision of the judges will be final.
6. This contest is open to all Indian residents only.
7. Deadline for submission: March 5th, 2023 (mid night).
8. Winners will be informed on 9th March, 2023 by mail / phone and will receive their awards during International Women's Day celebration on 10th March, 2023 at Indian Statistical Institute, Kolkata.
9. Indian Statistical Institute reserves the right to refuse entry of any image / photograph.
10. By submitting an image for the contest the participant will be regarded as having granted the organizer the right to use the image in print / softcopy, broadcast and / or electronic / social media without any fees payment, for the purposes of promoting the competition or areas related to the organiser's work including.
