

Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
3. Dedicated /toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support : BIDDER/OEM must have Dedicated/toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support.
4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Additional Terms and Conditions

1. MAF or OEM Certification is mandatory and should be specific to Bid Number and Bid Date. No general MAF will be accepted. Wherever Authorized Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorization Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid (Please refer to Annexure-2)
2. Bidder must produce at least one contract order copy of the supply of at least 50% of same product i.e., fresh/original battery of same category, in any of the last 3 FYs (2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23) against a single order from a Government/ Government Undertaking/ PSU/ Autonomous bodies. Copies of Orders along with their successful installation certificates have to be attached with the bid submitted.
3. Service Center: OEM should have a registered/authorized Service Centre in Kolkata. Valid documentary evidence to this effect needs to be provided.
4. 3 Years Warranty should be provided by the OEM

Scope of Work:

1. Disconnection of old batteries & reconnection of New Batteries with the designated UPS.
2. Placement of the supplied material at customer recommended sites, in two different battery rooms.
3. Supply of Garfilm sheet for each battery in the rack or equivalent.
4. Synchronization of current and voltage with the UPS in the presence of UPS OEM technical persons. Organization of the above is the sole responsibility of the supplier of battery. However, the supplier may seek help from the purchaser for necessary introduction.
5. Seller should be responsible for execution of entire Job in a timely manner and ensuring the quality of the product supplied.
6. Standard testing with site available load after completion of Battery installation
7. During the warranty period, yearly 2 times, battery discharge test with UPS, Individual battery voltage checking, should be done by OEM or its authorised persons.

8. On-site service support on the next working days.
9. Using PPE at the time of Battery I & C job
10. Ensuring proper electrical safety at the time of battery installation and commissioning

Bidder should inspect the site in advance at its own cost to check the UPS, BATTERY, RACK, CONNECTIVITY with main power supply as well as the UPS and other associated issues for smooth installation after the delivery of the goods. They should arrange all the components whatever will be necessary for the installation of the supplied battery.

(For site visit the bidder should contact Mr. Tuhin Biswas- 9477107500 and take prior appointment on the working days within 11 am- 5 pm only)

2. The existing connector and copper cables will have to be replaced with new one. The existing copper cables and connectors will not be given to the supplier.
3. In case of New rack is required the bidder have to include its cost in its price offer. The existing rack will not be given to the supplier.
4. The bidder will not be allowed to use the elevator for delivery of the battery at the recommended site.

Disclaimer

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.

7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
